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GILDERSOME SPORTS CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

Our Code of Conduct is for your comfort and safety and to ensure you enjoy your visit to Gildersome Sports Club.

At Gildersome Sports Club we aim to ensure that all those who use our facilities are able to do so in a safe, pleasant and friendly environment.

Persons using the Clubhouse / Ground are asked to consider other users at all times and not to put themselves or others at risk by their conduct.

Members/Patrons/Guests violating any rules or regulations of the club, or demonstrating behaviour deemed by the Committee to be detrimental to the welfare, good order, safety or character of the club or its Members/Patrons/Guests will be asked to leave the Club immediately and will be subject to the Club's disciplinary procedures.

This behaviour includes but is not restricted to foul, abusive or threatening language, rudeness or any form of racism, sexism etc., and the slightest hint of bullying or violence.

Members/Patrons/Guests must treat Staff, the Clubhouse and its facilities, the Grounds and other Members/Patrons/Guests with courtesy and respect at all times.

Children are to be supervised at ALL times both inside and outside the Clubhouse. In the interest of the safety and comfort of all Members/Patrons/Guests please do not allow your children to run around the Clubhouse or the Car Park, or climb on furniture / sporting equipment (Sight Screens, Nets, and Cricket Covers etc.)

In the interest of safety all types of balls or other items/objects manufactured for outdoor use should not be used in the Clubhouse.

No boots with any type of stud or spike are to be worn in the Bar/Lounge at any time.

Kit bags must not obstruct doors or walkthroughs. If any kit bags are found to be obstructing such areas they will be removed immediately.

The decisions of the Club Managers or person in charge of the Bar/Clubhouse are final in all aspects of Members/Patrons/Guests safety and comfort.

The Committee of the club reserves the right to amend this Code of Conduct as it sees fit and the Member/Patron/Guest shall observe any amended conditions or rules so made.

We can all play our part in ensuring that we enjoy the highest standards possible so that we can all be proud of our Club.

If there is any issue regarding behaviour, repairs or cleanliness then please raise this as soon as possible with the Club Management or Bar Staff so that appropriate action may be taken.
